

## Phone Usage and Cost Worksheet

This worksheet helps you calculate the total monthly usage and charges on your landline (fixed wire), long distance and cellular (mobile wireless) phone services. There are two types of monthly charges for phone service: recurring fees (for calling plans, features, surcharges, etc.) and usage charges (paid per minute or per item). Taxes and initial calling plan expenditures are not included in the worksheet.

To find the figures for an existing calling plan, look at the recent bills from your landline, long distance and cell phone service providers and at any recent calling cards you have used. To determine the cost of a prospective calling plan, read the details of the service provider's contract and speak with their customer service to clarify all the charges. Then estimate your phone usage and charges with that plan.

Determine your level of phone usage. Note if you have any special or unique calling habits or needs.

- Light (basic) user – Mostly local calling. Infrequent cellphone use.
- Medium (average) user – Mix of landline (some long distance) and cellular (mostly local).
- Heavy (advanced) user – Multiple phone lines and cellphones. Maybe high long distance usage.

Here are some ways you can reduce your spending on phone services:

- Reallocate your phone usage among local, long distance and cellular providers and calling cards.
- Eliminate duplicate services or features, such as long distance calling plans or voice mail services.
- Use a less expensive long distance service, such as a third-party provider or calling card.
- If included minutes are unused, get a cheaper plan with fewer included minutes.
- If you exceed included minutes and pay high rates, get a plan with more included minutes.
- Reduce usage of expensive per-use features, such as cellular roaming or peak-time calling.
- If you don't use the phone much, get measured local service, if available. Use a prepaid cellphone.

For third-party long distance service providers (not your local phone service provider) or long distance calling cards. List usage and charges for a typical month.

## Total Cost of All Phone Services

Summary of all charges for one month. List only whole dollars, not cents. Calculate the Percentage % of Total Amount (Cost) by dividing each Amount (Cost) by the Total Amount (Cost). Note any high proportion of spending on any of the service providers. Note any high proportion of spending on any of the usage or recurring charges.
